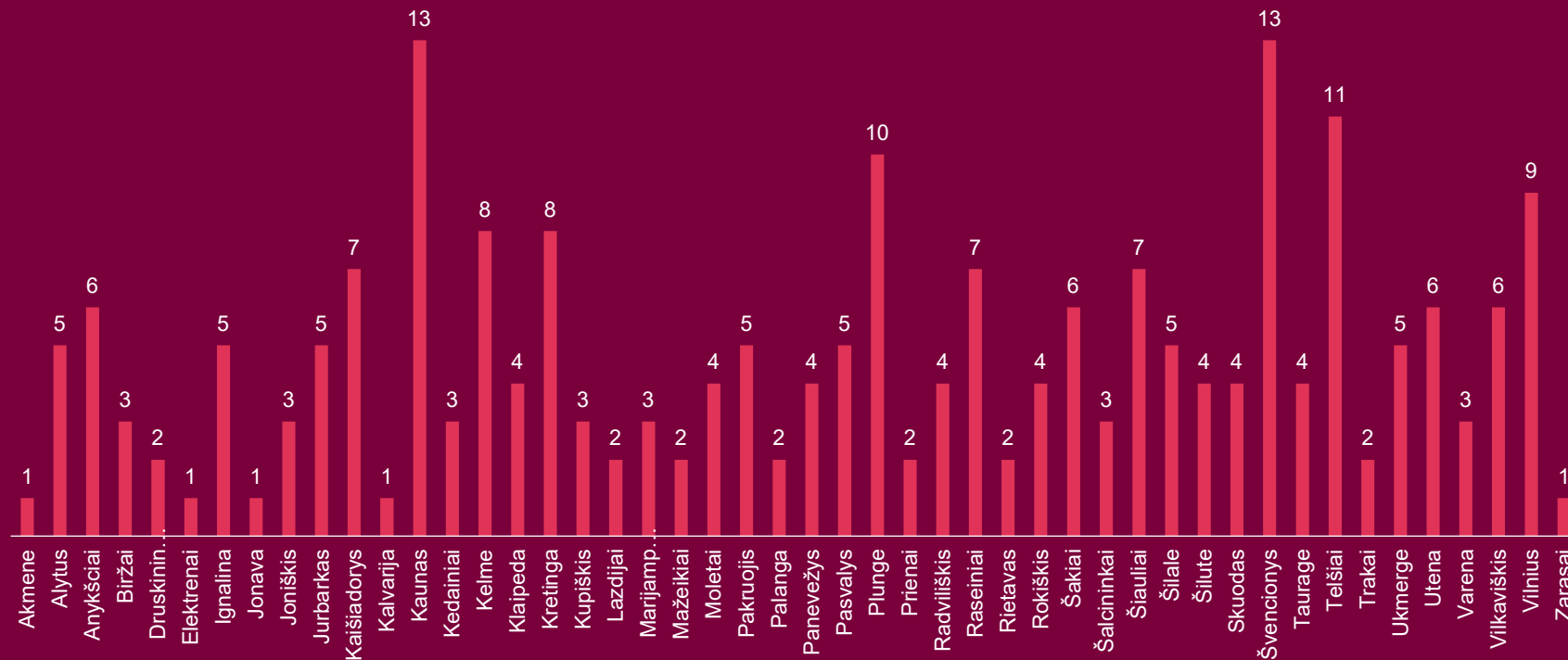
- Started in 2010 by VGJHM & *Gedenkdienst*

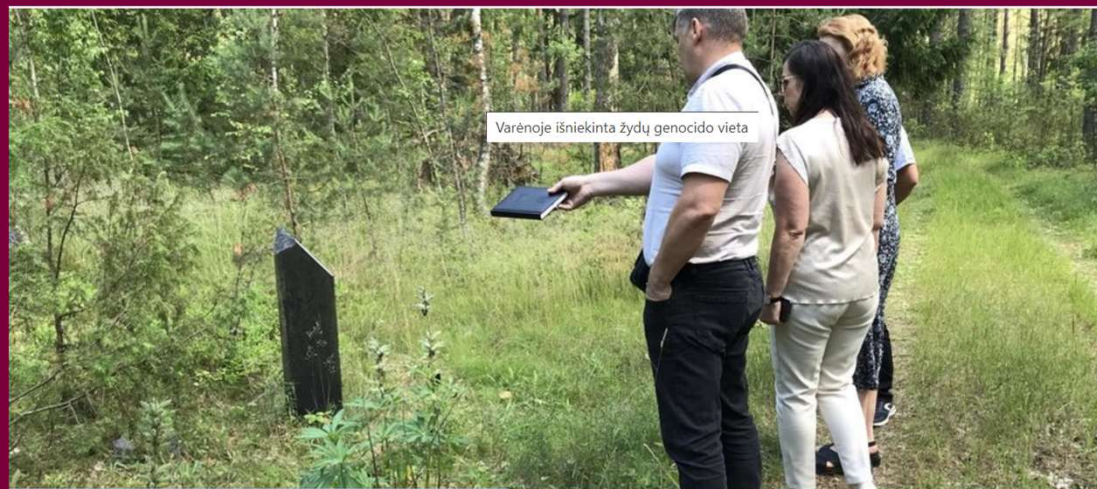
